Yarmouth received technical assistance through the Maine Community Energy Redevelopment Program (MECERP) to support locally determined revitalization projects at current and former industrial sites to support economic and clean energy goals (i.e., Wyman Station). EDAB has a Wyman Station Work Group that is determining next steps.

Strategy 4.3: Pursue 100% renewable energy reliance for government operations.

Action 4.3.1: Build upon current Municipal and School Power Purchase Agreement to meet 100% of current and forecasted electricity needs with renewable energy.



YCAB is working with the Town's Finance Director to understand the utilization of the solar power credits available from the Town's 20-year power purchase agreement before recommending augmentation.
